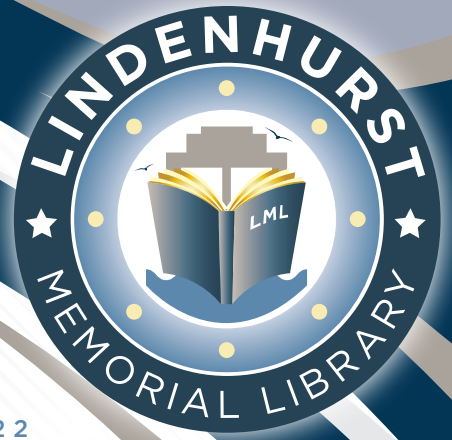

THE WAIT IS OVER!

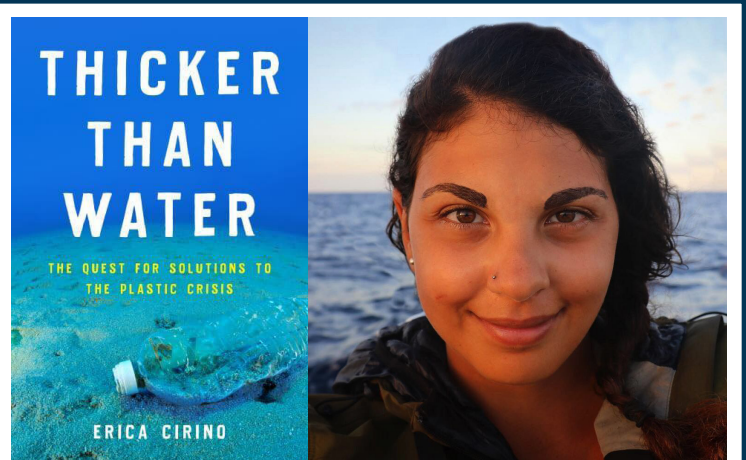

The Board of Trustees and staff of the Library want to offer a huge THANK YOU to our neighbors on Lee and Wellwood Avenue. We know that the project was disruptive and noisy at times, and we are very appreciative of the positivity and patience you afforded us throughout the project.

The Library is pleased to announce it is the recipient of a 2021/22 State Aid for Library Construction award of \$42,419 towards accessibility work during construction. Over the course of the building project, the Library applied for and received over \$300,000 in various grants to help lower the costs of construction for taxpayers.
